I am writing to give you an update on the works Five Rivers Environmental Contracting Ltd are carrying out along the river bank.

We are making good progress and have removed much of the scrub and a large section of the concrete wall in order to provide a more natural bank. Next on our 'To do' list is to complete the concrete removal, install the berms and deflectors in the channel, create the gravel riffle and pool sequence ahead of landscaping and installing the new play equipment.

We understand that the closure of the footpath and cycle path coupled with the increased activity is an inconvenience to those located close to the works area. We have tried to mitigate the impacts of this by using low pressures ground equipment and changed our methodologies whilst also ensuring that we are keeping members of the public and our site team safe.
